MARIN WORKFORCE HOUSING TRUST NAMES JACK MCLAUGHLIN TO BOARD OF DIRECTORS

NOVATO - The Marin Workforce Housing Trust announced today it has named Jack McLaughlin, president of the Marin Association of REALTORS®, to serve on its board of directors.

McLaughlin, a licensed real estate broker, has been engaged in the practice of residential real estate in Marin County for more than 25 years. He founded West Bay Properties in 1993, and publishes *The Marin Report*, a monthly news magazine on market trends and statistics with more than 3,500 subscribers.

The Marin Workforce Housing Trust, a 501(c)(3) non-profit corporation, was created in 2004 to expand workforce housing in Marin County. The trust was spearheaded by a group of concerned employers who formed a partnership with the Marin Community Foundation and the County of Marin.

All funds raised through corporate and private donations are matched on a dollar-for-dollar basis by both the foundation and the county of Marin. To date, the trust has raised over \$1 million.
